This year U18 dropped the combine testing and played in intersquad games before moving into Exhibition games with neighboring associations.

Great efforts were made by U15 A3 for finishing in second place in all 4 of their tournaments this year.

Congratulations to the 5 players from U15 A1 and the 1 player from U15 A2 moving to above minor for the upcoming 2023/2024 Hockey Season.

This year we had U11 A1 participate in the Toys for Tots at Christmas time. They were asked to donate a toy, and they helped box up all the donated toys from the event. U15 A3 gave back to the community this year by running a food drive for the Salvation Army.

Peter Hay and his development team continued providing development for our association. Peter and his coaches ensured top end player development as well as mentoring our coaches as they also participated during on ice sessions. Feedback received from players and their parents last year was incorporated into this season as best as we could based on ice availability and our budget. Feedback regarding our development programing was positive overall and AMHA will continue to build on our Development Program for next year. An area that people have requested further attention is in regards to a Coach Mentorship and AMHA has taken this into consideration with the hiring of Jamie Jackson as Coach Coordinator.
